*REFORM aims to trigger the SUMP development process and amplify the SUMP adoption rate in the cities of 4 European Regions*

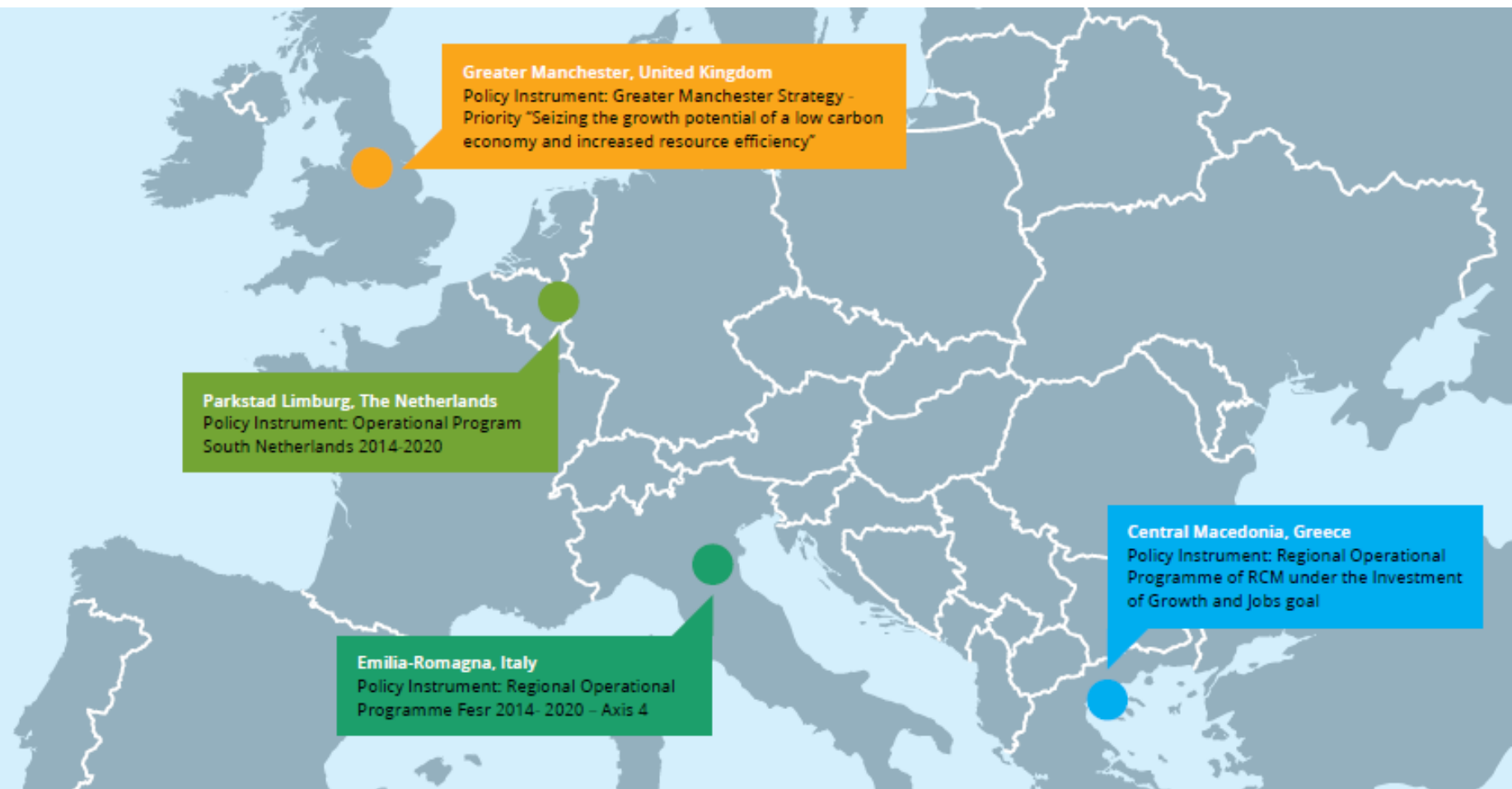


# REFORM specific objectives

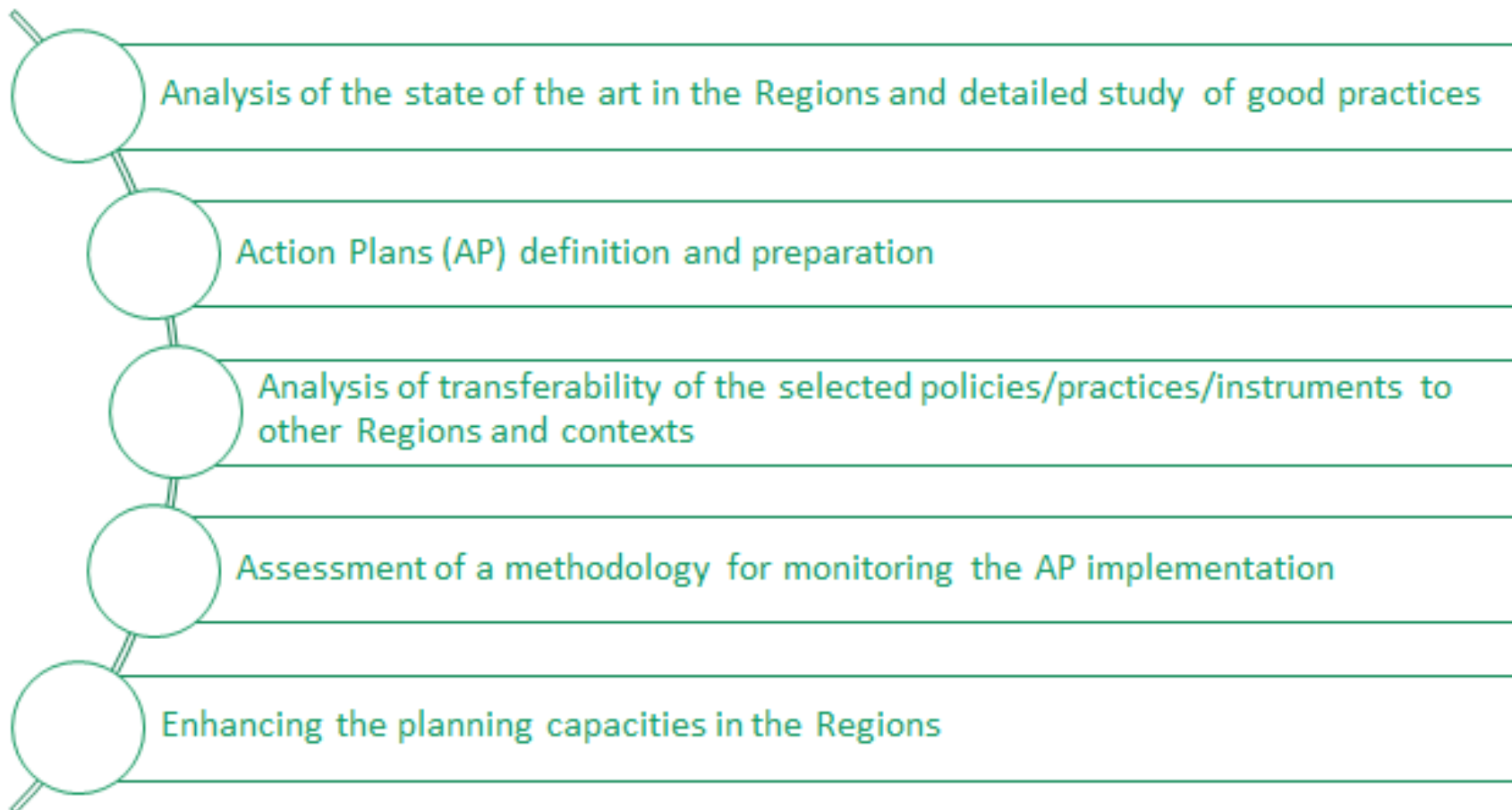

## Analysis of Good Practices (GPs)

### Methodology for selecting, describing and evaluating the GPs

**Identification of the state of development of SUMP's in the Regions**

**Definition of local needs and priorities**

**Collection of information about SUMP's development at European level**

**Identification and description of GPs at Regional and European level (25+ GPs have been described)**

**Evaluation of the collected GPs according to the needs of every Region**

# REFORM Exchange of experience

## Action Plans (APs) definition and preparation

The most suitable and effective GPs, for the specific needs of every participating region, will be considered in the preliminary Regional APs to support the adoption and funding of SUMP by the PIs.

A participatory approach for the preparation of the final APs is foreseen:

- ✓ ***citizens surveys***
- ✓ ***scientific cafes***
- ✓ ***focus groups with the technical sector***
- ✓ ***walk & talk" meetings with the local authorities***
- ✓ ***2 plenary stakeholders meetings***

will be organized in all 4 regions (*planned for the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester*) for exchange of opinions.

# REFORM Exchange of experience

## Enhancing the planning capacities in the Regions

2 stakeholder learning exchange events on SUMP and sustainable mobility planning (*planned for Dec 2017 – Jan 2018*) addressed to

- ✓ **Regional Public Servants**
- ✓ **Municipality and other relevant Public Servants of the regions**

with focus on their role in:

- ❖ formulating regional strategies to concrete measures/actions in cities' SUMP
- ❖ developing specific multi stakeholder participatory process for enhancing the development of local SUMP
- ❖ guiding cities during SUMP development ensuring their complementary in regional level

# REFORM APs implementation

## Phase 2 APs implementation follow-up

- ✓ Monitoring of the progress of the AP implementation
- ✓ Mobilization of the relevant stakeholders
- ✓ Exchange of the success and difficulties met in the implementation of the APs
- ✓ Evaluation of the outcomes of the implementation of the APs

# What do we want to achieve?

REFORM will achieve a rate of 60% of local authorities to have completed the SUMP adoption process, in the four REFORM regions.

# How are we going to achieve this?

- Number of policy learning events organized = 36
- Number of good practices identified = 25
- Number of people with increased professional capacity due to their participation in interregional cooperation activities = 150
- Number of action plans developed = 4
- Number of appearances in media (e.g. press) = 30
- Average number of sessions at the project pages per reporting period = 1500



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
